The Chippewa Township Board will be holding an informational meeting on Saturday, August 17, 2019 at 9 a.m. at the Chippewa Township Community Center; located at 10467 19 Mile Road. The purpose of this meeting is to hear from the Chippewa Township residents as to how they would like to see Chippewa Township proceed regarding licensed recreational marihuana establishments within the township.

The release of the Emergency rules on July 3, 2019; provides local municipalities and prospective licensees with the information they need to decide how they want to participate in this new industry. LARA will start taking business applications Nov. 1, Municipalities will have four months to evaluate these rules and make their decisions. These rules set Michigan's marijuana industry on a path for success while ensuring safety for marijuana consumers

Under the Emergency rules; persons may apply to the agency for state licenses in the following categories: class A marihuana grower (500 plants), class B marihuana grower (1,000 plants), class C marihuana grower (1,500 plants), enhanced grower (7500 plants) marihuana processor, marihuana retailer, marihuana safety compliance facility, marihuana secure transporter, marihuana microbusiness (150 plants) and consumption establishments.

The Township Board encourages all property owners to participate in this important topic, as it relates to our Township.
