When the Chippewa Township Board held a Marihuana Informational Meeting in August 2019, we stated we would be transparent through this process. This letter is to inform you of the next decision facing the residents of Chippewa Township.

In December of 2019 a Citizens Initiated Petition was turned into the Chippewa Township Clerk. A Citizens Initiated Petition means a petition signed by a certain minimum number of registered voters can force a government to choose to either enact a law or hold a public vote.

On the March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary Election ballot registered voters, of Chippewa Township, will be voting on the Marihuana Ordinance Proposal. Whether you vote no or yes, it is important for your voice to be heard! If you are a registered Voter in Chippewa Township and would like an absent voter application, please contact the Township Clerk or the Township offices and we will be happy to send you the application. As of 2019, anyone can vote absentee.

Remember, to vote in the March 2020 election, now is the time to voice your opinion and help the Township Board with this difficult decision to do what is best for our community.
