IMPORTANT INFORMATION – 2025 WINT TAX INFORMATION

2025 Winter Tax Bills are due on or before 2/17/2026. POSTMARKS will be accepted. On 2/18/2026 late penalties will apply. DELINQUENT 2025 Summer Taxes or Deferred Summer Taxes are **NOT** reflected on the 2025 winter tax bill. On

March 1, 2026, all unpaid taxes are TURNED OVER DELINQUENT and become payable to the Mecosta County Treasurers Office at 400 Elm St. Big Rapids, MI 49307 (231)592.0169 & are subject to additional penalties. **IF YOUR TAXES ARE ESCROWED, A MORTGAGE CODE APPEARS ON YOUR BILL AND A COPY OF THE 2025 WINTER TAX BILL HAS BEEN SENT TO YOUR MORTGAGE COMPANY. BY LAW, THE ORIGINAL BILL MUST BE SENT TO THE PROPERTY OWNER (MCL 221.11(1))**

Make Payments Payable to: Chippewa Township Treasurer. **Mail your payments to:** Chippewa Township Treasurer, P.O. Box 26, Chippewa lake, MI 49320. There is a secure drop box located to the right of the Chippewa Township Office Entry door. A self-addressed stamped envelop is requested for the return of your paid receipt. **If making payment in 'cash' please have the exact amount. CHIPPEWA TOWNSHIP DOES NOT ACCEPT CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS.** The Treasurer/Clerk office hours are Monday-Thursday from 9 AM-1PM with additional hours as needed. The Treasurer's Office will be closed December 23rd through December 26th and December 30th through January 4th.

*******EXTREMELY IMPORTANT*******

Make sure you carefully check the enclosed Tax Statement(s). If you find an error, please contact the Treasurer **Immediately** to have the statement corrected at the December 9, 2025, Board of Review. Upon the adjournment of the December 2025 Board of Review, corrections **cannot** be made to the 2025 Tax Roll, until the 2026 July Board of Review. The December Board of Review is for "Qualified Errors & Poverty Appeals **ONLY**. The 2025 taxes are assessed to a property as it existed on 12-31-2024 (MCL211.2). If a property is sold or split during the 2025 tax year, it is the responsibility of the buyer and seller or their agents to prorate the whole tax year obligation. **ALL** address changes need to be submitted in writing. **Failure to receive a property tax notice does NOT prejudice the right to collect or enforce the payment and or penalties, of the payment of the property tax.**

DISABLED VETERANS' EXEMPTION: Honorably discharged veterans with 100% permanently and totally disabled veteran classification or their surviving unmarried spouse, may be eligible for exemption from real property tax, for property that is used & owned as their principal residence.
