2026 Non-Hazardous Household Clean-Up Day: *Mark your calendars!* The Chippewa Township Clean-up is scheduled for Saturday, May 2, from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m. or **until dumpsters are full**. The location is at the Chippewa Township Community Center located at 10467 19 Mile Road. Please remember that all loose trash **must** be put into trash bags, large items must be cut into a manageable size, and **please have help to unload**. Each property owner is limited to (1) pickup and (1) trailer load. This service is provided, free of charge, to the property owners & residents of Chippewa Township Only! No early drop-offs and no tires, please! If you are building or remodeling, please get your own dumpster. No building materials are allowed.

Chippewa Lake Weed Control District Meeting Reminder

Join us on May 16, 2026, at 9 A.M. at the Chippewa Township Community Building and learn more about the health of our great lake and how we are making sure that the lake is here for generations to come. You will hear from PLM lake management group, who provided monitoring and treatment services in 2025. You will also hear from the Chippewa Lake Weed Advisory Committee volunteers who also monitor our lake throughout Spring, Summer and Fall. There will be questions and answers along with the opportunity to sign the Weed Control Petition.

CEMETERY NEWS

Spring Clean-Up will soon start at all four Cemeteries. **Please remember that ALL artificial flowers must be in an approved container**. This allows the Cemetery Sexton to be able to weed whip around the headstones. **Artificial flowers that are not in a container will be removed!** NO snowmobiles, golf carts, four wheelers, or similar vehicles are allowed inside any cemetery: according to Michigan law. For reference, you can find the Chippewa Township Cemetery Ordinance at www.chippewatwp.org. Click on the 'Community' tab then click on Cemeteries.

It will soon be time to start mowing and trimming our lawns. **Please** be courteous to your neighbors and keep your lawns mowed on a regular basis. Do not throw your grass clippings, old flowerpots, & shrubbery, onto other properties. It is not only unsightly, but unhealthy to our waterways.

CHALLENGE: We are challenging property owners to clean up the roadway along their property or help a neighbor with theirs, the Friday before Township Clean-up Day. All trash can be disposed of on Clean-up Day. What a great way to start Spring, by helping your neighbor and keeping our community clean!

The Annual Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection day is August 6, 2026, from 2 P.M. to 6 P.M. at the Mecosta County Fairgrounds, 540 West Ave, Big Rapids.
