

Early Voting

All Michigan voters now have the right to vote early in every statewide and federal election. In those elections, early voting must be offered for at least nine consecutive days, beginning on the second Saturday before the election and ending on the Sunday before the election, for at least eight hours a day. The first election at which early voting will be constitutionally required will be the 2024 presidential primary election.

Permanent Mail Voter List

Michigan voters now have the right to sign up to become a permanent mail in voter, that is, to submit one signed application that will enable them to receive an absentee ballot before all future elections. *However, the address that you use on the Permanent Voter application is the only address where your ballot will be mailed to.* By law, The USPS cannot forward Election mail. If you go out of town for the Winter months, your ballot will be mailed to your home address. If you have checked the box on the voter application; to be a Permanent Voter; and you now decide that isn't a good option for you, the **ONLY** way to be removed from the Permanent Voter List is to request in writing, that you'd like to be removed.
